- Martyr Flight Lieutenant Maheesh Trikha was born on 02 January 1975 at Military Hospital, Dehra Dun Cantt, Uttrakhand.
- All India UPSC topper, joined Pratap Section of Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehra Dun in July 1986.
- Joined National Defence Academy, Pune during 1992 with 88 NDA course in the Hunter Squadron.
- Adventurous by nature, Maheesh took the challenges of open sky and decided to join the Indian Air Force.
- Maheesh got commissioned as Pilot Officer (Pilloo) on 29th June 1996 from Air Force Academy, Dundigal as a Helicopter Pilot in the elite service, The Indian Air Force.
- His 1st Career posting was with Flamingos Squadron at Air Force Station, Jam Nagar, Gujarat.
- As a volunteer, joined 114 Helicopter Unit (HU), IAF at Leh during April 2001 (Siachin Pioneers).
- Siachin Pioneers of Indian Air Force trained Maheesh to be a Glacier Pilot.
- Maheesh, while returning to the base camp after accomplishment of his operational task at Siachin Glacier kept the RIMC motto - "Cradle of Excellence Where Gallantry is a Tradition", valiantly gave his life for the country in Air Force uniform at 0941 hrs on the 16 August 2002 under Operations "Meghdoot" & "Parakram" and became Martyr.

Childhood - 02 January 1975-July 1986

Maheesh, an intelligent and curious boy spent his childhood in the



Army Environment and Surroundings. He studied in Holy Cross School Dimapur, Nagaland from where he appeared for the UPSC RIMC Entrance Examination and stood 1st in All India UPSC RIMC Entrance Examination for July 1986 Batch.

We play, learn and grow with an idea to bring street children of the BPL families together, who could not get chance to go to proper school and thus became the purpose of opening of Matyr Flight Lieutenant Maheesh Trikha Coaching Institute also known as M-Trix Institute. On 02nd Jan 2010 the Coaching Institute was inaugurated by Dr. Priva Ranian

Trivedi, Pro-Chancellor and Plenipotentiary of 'The Global Open University', Nagaland. Women labour and maids leaving their young toddlers at the Institute while going for day's work. Teachers are employed to take care as per their age group. Starting the day with prayer followed by yoga, getting


familiar with power of nature, celebrating all the festivals like Saraswati Pooja/ Holi/ Deepawali/ X-Mas/ Eid etc and National days of India. Children learn through slates and chalks, expressing through crayons on drawing copies, singing native poems and songs, competition through numbers at the institute.





Hygiene is the main concern of toddlers as they are taught to maintain cleanliness and personal hygene. Teacher trimming their nails, washing their feet and distributing clothes, shoes, medicines etc. Providing snacks and clean water to drink.

Counselling all the parents from time to time and making them aware about environment, needs of the children, their own good & bad. Sports is the main attraction. Boys like to play cricket, races are held for toddlers, girls like to dance and sing native songs.
